
FORGOTTEN CHILDREN

Millions of children are falling through the cracks

Right now, children in desperate need of medical care and support in the poorest communities of the world are being left behind. Too often, these children are overlooked by governments and international development organizations. And each day, kids are dying.

Children living in poverty with disability are too often seen as less valuable, cursed, less than human. They're hidden away, sometimes out of shame, but more often because parents are trying to keep their kids safe while families struggle to put food on the table and a roof over their heads.

The sad reality is, too many of these beautiful kids are dying of neglect, sickness, abuse and loneliness. Misunderstanding, stigma and exclusion surrounding disability pull entire families into deeper poverty. And deeper poverty makes children more vulnerable to abuse, isolation, infection, further disability. It's a vicious cycle that we're out to break.



Shamirah developed knock knees when she was almost two years old. She struggled to move around freely. Neighbours made fun of the way she walked. Shamirah desperately needed medical care to have straight, strong legs that no longer caused her pain with each step. But money was beyond tight for this family. Medical care was out of reach. Sadly, many parents in the poorest communities can't afford treatment for their kids who have a disability, and they live in fear for their child's future.

Too many children like Shamirah live in needless pain and are left behind because of their disability.

When Cloud started walking, his mom noticed his legs were bending outwards. She thought Cloud's legs would correct as he got older, but nothing changed as he grew. His bowed legs only got worse.

Cloud needed corrective surgery to be able to run and play on legs that are straight and strong – and to chase his dream of becoming a famous football player. "I wish I could become an international footballer just like Ronaldo,

but my friends don't let me join in, saying my legs are not for a player," he told us.

Cloud's parents worried for their son and wanted to help him. They asked people in their community for advice. Thankfully, a friend told Cloud's mom about Hope and Healing's partner hospital where Cloud could get care. And because of kind Canadians like you, Cloud received the surgery that straightened his legs and restored his hope.

What does it take for girls and boys with disabilities in the poorest countries and communities to live healthier, happier, longer lives?

It requires valuing and nurturing the whole child – body, mind and spirit. Health starts with essential services, and happy lives are lived in the context of healthy relationships in the home, in school and in communities.

Our programs are child and ability-centred, driving healthy bodies, learning minds and resilient spirits through the following sectors:





HEALTH

- Quality, timely treatment for preventable, curable impairments
- Comprehensive rehabilitation plans that celebrate each child's unique abilities
- Families committed to fulfilling these treatment and rehabilitation plans



FAMILY LIVELIHOOD

- Equipping parents with a sustainable income to keep children healthy and in school
- Access to vocational skills, equipment, training and micro-finance loans
- Medical treatment for caregivers that allows them to support and care for their families



EDUCATION

- Parents and teachers educated and empowered to advocate for and support the unique needs of children with impairments
- Making school buildings and school latrines accessible to all kids
- Teaching kids about disability-preventing health and hygiene through school clubs



SOCIAL ATTITUDES

- Changing negative attitudes towards disability – in the community, church, school – all around the children we serve
- Training community members to understand the causes of impairment and the rights and potential of children with disabilities



SELF-VALUE

- Healing hearts and bodies, as children with disabilities overcome stigma and claim their intrinsic value as beautiful children of God

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2024 AT A GLANCE

NEW LEADERSHIP, RENEWED FOCUS

In 2024, we welcomed Peter Kyalo Mwalimu as the new Executive Director of Hope and Healing International. Faithful friends like you embraced Kyalo warmly as he brought his expertise, passion and faith to this leadership position. Kyalo demonstrates a clear focus on holistic care for children, as well as commitment to growth and keeping Jesus central.

As we look back at 2024, we're thrilled to see the hundreds of thousands of lives changed this year because of you. You may notice that our impact numbers this year are lower than last year. In 2023's annual report, we included all the millions of children and families (6.1 million) who were reached by health promotion with disability sensitization messages through radio and social media. While we believe that these activities have direct, positive impact on many lives, we don't currently have a way to measure behaviour change or health impacts as a result of these broadcasts. So, this year we've removed these "reach" numbers from our total count of children with disabilities whose lives have been transformed by our work.





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YOUR CHILD HEALTH IMPACT

Because you chose to put Jesus' love in action, children are living healthier, happier, longer lives! Through surgery, medication, rehabilitation, clean water, kids are experiencing God's love in a real, practical way. Friends like you are telling these beautiful kids that they are worth medical care. You are being Jesus' hands and feet to transform their lives with hope and healing!

Last year, you gave **504,680** children access to disability-preventing care, medical treatment and rehabilitation plans.

DISABILITY-PREVENTING CARE

Because of you, **410,792** children received disability-preventing care!



You gave **177,075** children in Cameroon blindness-stopping medication to help end River Blindness.



You provided **84,938** children with disability-prevention services like medical screenings, health education and more.



Because of you, **77,760** children benefitted from the SAFE program (Surgery, Antibiotics, Face-washing, Environmental change) to stop the spread of blinding trachoma in their communities.

REHABILITATION

Because of you, **8,918** children received rehabilitative support!



Thanks to the kindness of Canadians like you, **6,812** children received physiotherapy, occupational therapy, rehabilitative support to strengthen muscles.



You gave **2,106** children assistive devices like prosthetic devices, leg braces and wheelchairs.



You gave a total of **5,190** physiotherapy sessions to kids in need.



YOUR FAMILY LIVELIHOOD IMPACT

Because of your support, children are benefitting from the livelihood training and support, as well as the medical care, that their caregivers have received. When caregivers have the support they need, they can better provide for their children with disabilities by putting food on the table and sending their children to school – tangible hope that will last for years to come.

You supported **66,387** children by providing medical, supportive care (including assistive devices) to their caregivers, so parents could better care for their families.



Through your generosity, **4,560** children benefitted from their caregivers participating in the SAFE Strategy (Surgery, Antibiotics, Facewashing, Environmental change) to stop the spread of blinding trachoma.

You made sure **7,238** children with disabilities and families were included in government support programs.



YOUR EDUCATION IMPACT

Because of you, children with disabilities were able to go to school. Ramps, accessible latrines, education supports, teacher training in disability-inclusive education and more gave these kids the chance to learn and grow alongside their peers. Thank you for showing them Jesus' love by welcoming them into the classroom!



Friends like you gave Tanda treatment to straighten his knock knees, and you gave him a backpack full of school supplies! Last year, you gave **69,545** kids access to education supports so they can become all God created them to be!



You gave **6,354** kids the chance to go to school by providing school fees, supplies, transportation.



Because of you, **56,461** children with disabilities received informal education through educational programming.



By training teachers on disability-inclusive education, you supported **6,730** children.



A PAIN-FREE WALK TO SCHOOL

Boris and Valdes are brothers both born with knock knees. Despite the pain they face with each step, they're determined to walk to school so they can learn and reach for their dreams.

For too many kids with disabilities in the poorest communities, getting an education is impossible. They face barriers to school such as a lack of ramps, no accommodations to see the blackboard or limited specialized learning supports. For kids like Boris and Valdes, the walk to school can be unbearable.

Boris told us, "I want to go to school so that I will become a doctor and treat people when they are sick. But sometimes when I walk to school, I feel pain in my legs and some people in school often insult our legs."

These bright boys needed surgery. But their family simply couldn't afford medical care.

Thanks to kind friends like you, Boris and Valdes received the surgeries they needed to straighten their legs. These two can't wait to walk to school without pain, and learn with their friends.

And Canadians like you gave them school materials – bags, books, pens – to set them up for success! Thank you for giving kids with disabilities the care and resources they need to learn and thrive.


Because of you, **2,970** children with disabilities were welcomed into play, sports, cultural and social activities in their communities.

FREE FROM SHAME AND STIGMA

Baby Ryan was born with cleft lip and palate. The split in his lip and gap in the roof of his mouth made breastfeeding nearly impossible for this little one.

His mom worried as her son grew more and more malnourished. Ryan and his family were ridiculed by their community out of a lack of understanding and stigma. "When I had given birth to Ryan, people used to say, 'Let's go and see that child who has no mouth'. At one point, I even had to move Ryan and take him to my sister's place because people were overwhelming me to come and see and

strong. And surgery would also show his community that his disability was not a curse. Thankfully, Ryan and his mom came to our partner hospital for the care he needed. And kind friends like you covered his surgery and care – a cost that was too much for this family to afford.

After the successful surgery, Ryan's community was shocked. "They never thought this could be done. They couldn't believe that Ryan would be recovered," his mom told us.

Thank you for giving Ryan the chance to grow healthy and strong. And for fighting the misunderstanding and stigma around cleft lip and palate.



GAINING CONFIDENCE, GROWING HOPE

14-year-old Josephine was born with spina bifida, affecting both her ability to walk and her confidence. Neighbours would laugh and mock Josephine, and other children excluded her from play. Josephine became withdrawn and self-conscious. She didn't want to participate in activities or join in with her friends. Josephine's spark of joy and self-esteem was dwindling.

Josephine's mom was approached by one of our partner staff, inviting her daughter to enroll in Hope and Healing International's Resilience Program. And it didn't take long for Josephine's confidence and joy to be restored! Her mom told us, "After a few lessons,
Josephine started being jolly, open
and even playing with other children –
something I had never seen in my child.
She even started singing in church and
participating in school debates. Thanks
to Hope and Healing for changing my
daughter's life and giving her confidence."

Now, since graduating the program, this beautiful girl is out of her shell and has gotten her joy – and hope – back. She's learned to see herself as Jesus sees her. Thank you for making this heart-healing work possible.

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MATERNAL NEWBORN HEALTH HIGHLIGHT



YOU gave babies life-saving equipment

Our local partner in Zambia recently opened a safe birthing centre – a "maternal annex".

Generous Canadians like you made sure this annex is well-equipped for all the moms and newborns who will use it. You shipped vital equipment to Zambia last year – including life-saving baby warmers, birthing beds, an ultrasound machine.

Because of your generosity, the facility will be a safe birthing place for young moms, moms facing highrisk pregnancies, and women who live in the most rural areas away from healthcare services.

Thanks to you, vulnerable babies in Zambia are getting the intensive and life-saving care they need.

Together, kind friends like you provided more than \$2.5 million worth of vital equipment and supplies to over 100 hospitals across rural Zambia, including:

Baby warmers	Stethoscopes
Birthing beds	An ultrasound machine
Mattresses	Anesthesia equipment
Hospital beds	Bedside monitors
Instrument sterilizers	Exam tables

YOU gave HOPE to Baby Chimwemwe

"The moment I looked at her, I was scared that I was going to lose my first child," Clara told us. Her daughter, Chimwemwe, was born with gastroschisis – a condition that meant Chimwemwe's intestines extended outside of her abdomen through a hole near her belly button.

"I felt so hopeless and I cried uncontrollably. My husband and my mother were my pillar of strength in that moment. My mother encouraged me not to despair or lose hope, and trust that God will use the medical staff to heal my baby."

Everything felt fragile to Clara those first few days. She didn't know what would happen to her daughter. Doctors continued to provide the care Chimwemwe needed, and thanks to donors from Hope and Healing, Chimwemwe had a bassinet to lay in. This bassinet was more than a bed. It was Chimwemwe's home, a soft place of comfort and safety for a little baby vulnerable to illness.

Day after day, Chimwemwe grew stronger, and a month later, Clara saw her baby smile for the first time. "My hope was revived in that moment, and I knew that my baby was going to be okay," Clara said.

Thank you for giving hope to moms like Clara and ensuring babies like Chimwemwe have a bright future ahead of them.

RENEWED HOPE



Zambia Food Crisis

In August, catastrophic drought swept across Southern Africa, leaving already-vulnerable children starving and malnourished. Zambia was one of the countries most affected.

Clean water sources dried up. Children were drinking dirty, contaminated water. Crops that were supposed to be drought resistant failed. Parents had no way to feed their children. More than **6 million** girls, boys, women, men across Zambia went without food – leaving **1 million** children suffering from malnutrition.

The effects of malnutrition on kids are devastating – children become bloated and listless, their bodies and brains are often left with deficiencies and damage. That's if they survive.

Children with disabilities are too often forgotten in crisis situations. Many children aren't on government food aid lists and moms choose not to leave children alone to stand in food lines for their safety. If children and families with disabilities aren't prioritized, they don't get the care they desperately need. Most of these families face poverty that is deeper and more crushing than their neighbours. Emergencies like this too often take away their last hope for survival.

We came to you with an urgent request, asking you to provide life-saving treatment, food packages, clean water and crop restoration packages to families across Zambia.

And you've been Jesus' hands and feet to these families in a desperate situation.

YOUR IMPACT

- You're giving malnourished children intensive care:
 - Therapeutic milk powder
 - Plumpy'Nut used to treat severe malnutrition in children
- You're distributing food packages to children and families facing starvation:
 - Instant soya milk rich in vitamins
 - Nutrient-rich food
- You're supplying families with cropenhancing fertilizer and seeds for next planting season:
 - Maize, ground nuts and bean seeds
 - Crop-enhancing fertilizer
- You're providing chlorine tablets to purify bacteria-filled water.

Because of your generosity, the first wave of care and support to Zambian families is well underway. And as the crisis continues, your ongoing care and support is showing Jesus' tangible love to the most vulnerable children and families.



Kenya Flooding Crisis Update

Last January, floods devastated children and families across Kenya, leaving over 200,000 children displaced. Homes were destroyed. Families lost livestock, crops, businesses. Thousands of children faced severe acute malnutrition. This already dire situation was made worse by political instability and rioting that took place in July.

These already-vulnerable children and families desperately needed food to survive – along with medicine, medical care and funds to replace and rebuild all that was lost.

Because of generous Canadians, you gave life-saving support to **2,246 kids, moms and dads** devastated from all the loss. Your kindness gave many families hope. You've shown kids with disabilities and their families that they matter and are not forgotten.

Through your generosity, you gave:

300 food packages, which totalled:

- 3,000 kgs rice
- 2,400 kgs maize flour
- 2,400 kgs wheat flour
- 1,500 litres cooking oil
- 600 kgs sugar
- 600 bars of soap
- 300 kgs salt
- 3,000 kgs green grams (peas)

900 support vouchers for medicine, livestock and school fees.

376 sessions of post-trauma counselling to kids and caregivers.

178 medical assessments, surgeries and assistive devices for children.

HEALING BODIES, HEALING HEARTS

Our medical partners are filled with deeply Christian doctors, nurses, staff members who live out the Gospel and show Jesus' light to each patient they serve. They are motivated by the love of Christ and walk in His footsteps each day. Many of our partners have chaplains who pray with children and parents before surgery. Our partners also work with and train local pastors to identify and advocate for kids with disabilities and share the good news of Jesus in their own cultural context.

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OUR PROGRAM APPROACH

How we work is as important as what we do. It's part of who we are and it's how we change lives.

Christian

As Christians, we believe that *all* children are made in God's image. As such, all children, with their unique abilities, have intrinsic value and a God-given purpose in life. Every action and word we deliver through our programs at Hope and Healing are intended to communicate God's love for the children we serve.



Child-Centred

We are child-centred and believe that girls and boys with disabilities and their families are the experts in their lives, that their voices matter, and they inform our work.



Family-Based

We are partner-centred with authentic, collaborative, and long-term partnerships. Partners are well positioned to implement projects for vulnerable children because they are trusted in their communities and connected within existing networks and systems. They amplify our impact.



Accountable

We strongly believe in accountability to our partners, to our donors, and most importantly to girls and boys with disabilities and their families to ensure that our work is changing hearts and lives.



Rights-Based

Our work is rights-based and recognizes that those who are most marginalized, children with disabilities, face the biggest barriers to realizing their rights. That's why we work within the framework of:


- The UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD)

12-year-old Leo fractured his foot after falling out of a mango tree. His parents wanted to bring him to the hospital, but a traditional herbalist in the community insisted that he would be able to heal Leo's foot quicker than doctors would.

Leo's family hoped that the herbalist would be able to help. But after many costly treatments, Leo's foot became worse and worse. Without proper care, Leo's whole leg became infected.

They rushed Leo to the hospital, but it was too late. The doctor told Leo's family that his bone was infected. Leo's foot needed


to be amputated to stop the infection from spreading further. Thankfully, friends like you paid for Leo's surgery and gave him a pair of crutches shipped with love from Canada.



OUR FINANCIALS

Based on the current global economy, we knew that 2024 would be another year of rising inflation that would mean higher costs for our local partners and for our donors. We had also seen our donors' incredible generosity over the past several years. With all these factors in mind, we set our target for our 2024 year at \$29.7M. Thanks to the faithful generosity of incredible supporters like you, we surpassed this target by 20.6% to finish the year with a total of \$35.8M.




